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Investors Community Bank moves to new Stevens Point location

(Manitowoc, WI, February 1, 2016) Investors Community Bank (ICB) has moved its Stevens Point operations to a new banking center at 5517 Vern Holmes Drive, effective February 1, 2016. The 13,184-square-foot facility replaces the bank's current office on Church Street and will continue to provide the same comprehensive financial services.

"We're pleased to have a larger bank space in Portage County that will provide an even better banking experience for our customers and the community," stated Tim Schneider, CEO and Co-Founder, Investors Community Bank. "With a beautiful, welcoming design, visitors will experience a warm, comfortable atmosphere that focuses on the customer and also aligns with our brand look. This is an investment in the community that shows we are committed to serving their long-term financial needs and building lasting relationships."

Ghidorzi Construction served as design/build contractor for the project. According to Chris Ghidorzi, VP of Property Development, "The building was designed to capture the spirit of Investors Community Bank by leveraging the influence of the agricultural sector on the bank's growth. Through features such as a dramatic vaulted ceiling, stone fire place and antique vault door, our design team was able to pay tribute to the heritage of ICB and the banking industry."

The lower level of the building includes a 1,100-square-foot meeting room adjacent to a full kitchen that can also serve as a community resource for nonprofit and civic groups to use. Green features are an integral part of the building, which incorporates Lean building principles that eliminate waste, including: LED lighting inside and out; concrete pavement to increase the reflectiveness of the parking lot at night and reduce the amount of parking light required; an air tight spray foam that envelopes the building to significantly enhance energy efficiency and regulate temperature, in conjunction with a computer controlled HVAC system; an in-floor heating system to warm workspaces while minimizing convection heat loss; high ceilings and tall windows throughout the building to optimize cool indirect daylight, with the use of transom and side lights to drive natural light deep in to the building; and light paint colors and interior finishes to capture and

bounce natural daylight throughout the space. Keeping future development in mind, the building design has flexibility for expansion to accommodate bank growth.

ICB first opened a banking center in Stevens Point in 2010 and has been leasing space since then. However, continued growth in the Portage County market required them to seek a different location. The new office is in a growing commercial area that maximizes market impact and increases visibility.

Investors Community Bank is a wholly-owned subsidiary of County Bancorp Inc. (CBI) and committed to offering customized financial solutions to Wisconsin's agriculture sector and closely-held businesses. Founded in 1997, Investors has become one of the most successful bank startups in Wisconsin's history, with full service offices in Manitowoc and Stevens Point and Loan Production Offices in Eau Claire, Darlington, Sheboygan and Fond du Lac.

On November 20, 2015 CBI (Nasdaq: ICBK), announced that they entered into a definitive agreement to merge with Fox River Valley Bancorp, Inc. Upon completion of the transaction, Fox River Valley's subsidiary bank, The Business Bank, with locations in Green Bay and Appleton, will be merged into Investors Community Bank.
